3. Approval of Votes and Proceedings of Wednesday, 2nd November, 2011.

4. Other Announcements by Mr. Speaker:

Mr. Speaker recalled that at the inception of this Fifth Assembly, this Honourable House received a letter from the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) nominating **Hon. Emma Okoduwa (Esan North East II)** for confirmation as the Minority Leader of the House, while a counter letter was also received from another faction of the Peoples Democratic Party (PDP) objecting to the said nomination noting that the Party recently concluded its Congresses without any further correspondence to the House on the issue. Mr. Speaker therefore said that the position of the House Minority Leader can not continue to be vacant. He then called for nomination for the position of the Minority Leader in the House by Members of the Peoples Democratic party (PDP).

Hon. Emma Okoduwa (Esan North East II) was consequently nominated by **Hon. Ehigialua, Monday (Esan West)** and seconded.

Motion made and Question Proposed; That **Hon. Emma Okoduwa (Esan North East II)** be confirmed as the Minority Leader of the House.
