### **3. Approval of Votes and Proceedings of Tuesday, 1st November, 2011.**

### **4. Other Announcements by Mr. Speaker:**

Mr. Speaker announced the receipt of a Petition and directed the Clerk to give the synopsis thus: “**Protest letter on the Activities of Edo State Waste Management Board On Traders In Lagos Street**” dated 1st November, 2011 and signed by one Martins Eboigbe and Others.
